Since 2006 the service has been receiving complaints regarding loud amplified music from the premises. The licence was transferred to the current holders on 13<sup>th</sup> June 2014.

On 10<sup>th</sup> October 2014 a meeting was arranged with the current licence holders to discuss concerns with regards to the operating of the premises, specifically noise from loud music and the congregating of patrons on the public highway to which both licence holders failed to attend.

On the same day a final warning letter was delivered to the premises by hand outlining the concerns with a view to addressing them and requesting they install a sound limiter as stipulated in Annex 2 of the premises licence.

Officers have visited the premises on a couple of occasions to inspect the device or check the progress and they have reported that there is no device in place. Additionally neither licensee has contacted the council as requested in the letter dated 10<sup>th</sup> October 2014.

Since this letter was hand delivered on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2014 the service continues to receive complaints from local residents with regards to loud music at the premises.

The Environment and Noise Enforcement Service is therefore seeking a review of this premises licence as it is our view that the current operation of the premises is undermining the licensing objective of prevention of public nuisance and the nuisance complained about is recurrent, more prevalently under the current management. We therefore ask Licensing Sub-Committee to amend the licence as follows:

1. To remove the provision of Recorded Music and Regulated Entertainment entirely, meaning only background music may be played throughout the premises
2. There shall be provision for Live Music pursuant to the Live Music Act 2012
3. The reduction of the terminal hour for all activities in line with the Council's Statement of Licencing Policy for the preferred hours for a bar/restaurant in a residential area as follows:
  - a) Sunday-Thursday 23:00 hours
  - b) Friday and Saturday 23:00 hours

(NB this includes the current provision for Interdependence Days for the countries listed in Part 1 of the premises licence)

4. As per 3a-b the provision of Late Night Refreshment to be removed from the premises licence
5. Where a Temporary Event Notice (TEN) is submitted and granted the licence holder will employ a minimum of 2 SIA trained staff from 22:00 hours for the duration of the event
6. Where a Temporary Event Notice (TEN) for the provision of Recorded Music and/or Regulated Entertainment is submitted and granted, the licence holder will ensure this is regulated by an automatic sound limiting device to control all amplified music and speech. This device is to be installed at the expense of the licence holder, pre-approved by the service and set to the satisfaction of enforcement officers. No TEN will be granted in the event this device is not installed.
